<Quarter System>


KUT employs a quarter system which one year is divided into four terms, and each term is called "quarter". In the quarter system, one quarter is generally completed in 8 weeks. 2-credit courses consist of fifteen 90minutes lectures plus a credit examination. 1st and 2nd Quarter are called Spring Semester and 3rd and 4th Quarter are called Fall Semester.

1st Quarter(Q1) From Early April to Early June 2nd Quarter(Q2) From Early June to Early August

3rd Quarter(Q2) From Beginning of October to Eary December

4rh Quarter (Q4) From Early December to Middle of February
