<Quarter System>

KUT employs a quarter system which one year is divided into four terms, and each term is called "quarter". In the quarter system, one quarter is generally completed in 8 weeks. 2-credit courses consist of fifteen 90minutes lectures plus a credit examination. 1st and 2nd Quarter are called Spring Semester and 3rd and 4th Quarter are called Fall Semester.

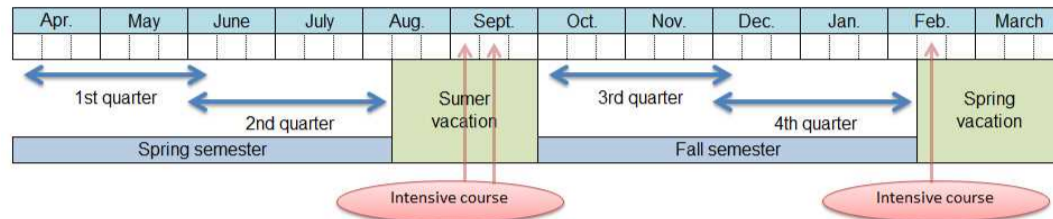
1st Quarter(Q1) From Early April to Early June

① Humanities and Social Science

Courses in this group are designed to help students acquire the liberal arts, languages, and basic skills for working adults.

② Natural Science

Courses in physics, chemistry, biology, mathematics and information technology.

③ Specialized Courses

This course is designed to provide students with the specialized knowledge necessary to complete their undergraduate studies.
