- **Applied Period: January 17th Monday – January 23th Sunday**
- If you must travel to an outbreak area (excluding Kochi Prefecture) during above period or travel to an area where a state of emergency has been declared or where the priority preventative measures are taken due to unavoidable circumstances, stay at home for 7 days after returning from an area, and monitor your own health thoroughly for another 7 days.
- Travel subject to restrictions: All travels, including personal travel, job hunting, extracurricular activities, research, academic conference participation, etc. (includes day trips)
