Salaya Campus

Mahidol University encompasses six campuses. Two of which are located in inner city Bangkok while the large suburban campus at Salaya (520 acres) is on the outskirts in Nakorn Pathom province. The other three provincial campuses are in the north, north-east, and west, to provide educational opportunities for those living in rural areas.

About 25 kilometers away from Bangkok, Salaya is accessible through public transportation as well as a shuttle service and the Salaya Link. The campus itself is unique in its natural beauty, landscaped gardens, and lush tropical scenery. It also houses Sirirukkachart Botanical Garden which is a center for Thai medicinal plants, a cultivation place for medicinal plant needed for research projects, and a self-study center opened for public. Salaya campus's major landmark is the iconic Prince Mahidol Hall. Its unique design will impress visitors at first sight. Apart from being an auditorium for the commencement ceremony, the Hall serves as an orchestra hall, an opera house and conference venue. State-of-the-art lighting, sound system, and stage engineering supported by consulting firms from Britain, France and Germany make the building one of the most advanced concert halls in Asia.
